




The Heartland Rural Innovators Initiative is a 14-month program supporting rural communities in Kansas and western Missouri as they grow their tech and innovation economies.

Tech-Based Economic Development (TBED) strengthens rural economies



TBED is an economic development approach that helps communities to:

diversify their *local economy*

create
in-demand tech
jobs

support homegrown innovation

retain and attract **talent**

prepare for the future of work

This process requires dedicated community leadership and collaboration

- → **Assessment phase** (months 1–3): Regular meetings with CORI team, data gathering, and stakeholder engagement
- → **Strategy phase** (months 3–6): Collaborative workshops, delivery of strategic recommendations, and alignment on priorities
- → Implementation support (months 7–12): Office hours and targeted technical assistance to pilot programs and/or apply for funding
- → Cohort summit (timing TBD): An in-person summit with peers to share learnings and successes





Eligible communities must demonstrate readiness and commitment

- 1. Rural communities (<50,000 population), located in the Patterson Family Foundation catchment area
 - In PFF catchment eligible
 - Outside PFF catchment ineligible



- 2. **Demonstrated local buy-in/support**: local champions, cross-sector leadership, stakeholder engagement with **willingness to build** and rally around a **shared vision**, and **openness to new models** of economic development
- 3. Readiness across key indicators such as broadband access, workforce training assets, and leadership capacity
- 4. **Commitment** to working with CORI for **up to 14 months**

- Deadline to apply: October 31st
